Christmas Fayre 2021

Seasonal Greetings to you,

We can't believe it's been a year either! Things seem to be slowly getting back to normal and that includes our Christmas Fayre. This year will see the stalls making a comeback, although a bit reduced on previous years. We are still in the process of finalising who will be here but will update you as soon as we know! We do recommend ordering early as demand seems to be high this year

Last year we introduced fixed prices. This worked well so we are keeping it in place so you know exactly what you will be paying, it means that we are able to take pre-payment, so on the day you just turn up and collect. We are also doing collection time slots, we are aware that this may make things a bit awkward for some people but we are trying to keep everyone safe, there will be hourly slots and you can show up at any time within that hour. Obviously if something goes wrong and you will be earlier or later than stated when you ordered all that time ago, just give us a quick message and we will sort it out!

One thing not changing are our suppliers so you will still enjoy the same great produce. Our suppliers are:

- Walters' Family Turkeys from Aldworth, (unofficially the tastiest turkeys!)
- Peach Croft Geese from Abingdon
- Vicars Game sausages, bacon, gammon & ham from Ashampstead
- White Pond Farm home reared Beef
- Turkey trimmings from Emily Rait Catering

To speed up the collection process we will be sending out an invoice on the 15th December, the invoice will have a link to pay by card or BACS and should all be relatively straight forward! If you do not wish to or unable to pay this way we can take payment on the day via card or cash, we are afraid we will no longer be accepting cheques.

Please take a look at our price list and mark your order on the form before returning it to us by email, phone, post or dropping in to us. We will allocate you an order number which we will use when you collect your fayre on **Thursday 23rd December between 10:00AM and 5PM.**

NB: There is a deadline of 1st December if ordering a goose & 10th December for turkeys, hams etc.

How much to order?

- A whole turkey allow 500 gm per person
- A crown (turkey on the bone with wings but legs removed) allow 333 gm per person
- A breast roast (breast meat only, no bones) allow 250 gm per person
- A goose allow 600 gm per person
- Royal roast will feed approximately 15 people
- 1 kg = 2.2 lbs or 1 lbs = 0.45 kg

How to pay

- We will aim to send out invoices on the 15th December
- We will have card payments this year (all being well)
